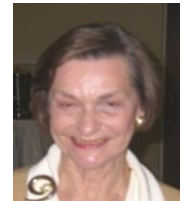
- **Jim Wine Man Mesquit** announced that he was looking for a coffee vendor for our Wine Country Evening, please call him!
